
Abstract

Pour pouvoir utiliser les programmes qui se trouvent dans le serveur google colab et récupérer des données Twitter, il faut :


- Un compte Twitter si ce n'est pas le cas, créez-en un,




Maintenant, quand vous appuyez sur le bouton "Apply for developer account", vous allez voir la page ci-dessous :




Si vous n'avez pas spécifié votre numéro de téléphone lors de la création de votre compte twitter, il vous est demandé d'en renseigner un pour continuer,


Une fois que vous avez validé votre numéro et le code de vérification, vous aurez une page pour compléter un certain nombre d'informations. Ci-dessous un exemple :




Ensuite vous tombez sur la page suivante, que vous remplissez, en cochant la case "Accept terms & conditions" :







Ensuite sur votre projet on va essayer de changer les permissions en lecture et écriture donc il faut cliquer sur set up :




Ensuite changer le « read » en « read and write » comme ci-dessous :



Et puis remplir le formulaire par exemple :





Enfin il faut confirmer les changements :

- Et puis dans access token and secret cliquez sur Generate




